Respected Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that the NEP 2020 has stressed upon the promotion of Indian Languages, Arts and Culture, and has recommended for the integration of Indian Knowledge System (IKS) into curriculums at all levels of education. In order to facilitate a seamless integration of Indian traditional knowledge with modern subjects, UGC has also come up with the guidelines for training /orientation of faculty on Indian knowledge system.

In this regard, the UGC in collaboration with the IKS Division of Ministry of Education is planning to organise six-day short term face to face training programme for 1000 teachers at six HRDCs (selected on the basis of geographical coverage) during July-October, 2023 as per attached schedule. The IKS Division has accumulated vast experience in this domain and would like to see the utilization of that knowledge for a national cause. Involvement of the IKS Division will help in empowering teachers to start teaching the foundational IKS Courses (As per the UG/PG guidelines of the UGC) in the academic year 2023-2024.

The Vice Chancellors of Universities and Principals of Colleges are requested to nominate two regular faculty members from their institution for taking part in the above mentioned training programme and submit the same at the following **UGC IKS Portal at www.ugciks.in**. Preference will be given to faculty (Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and full Professors, in that order) who are currently teaching/plan to teach an introductory course in IKS in the current (2023-2024) academic year. This programme will be treated at par with that of the short term course under the scheme of UGC HRDC.

Looking forward to an active participation of faculty members from your respective Institution in the IKS training programme.
