ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

Established in 2000, the Department offers M.Sc. and Ph.D. programs since 2001 and 2002, respectively. It provides interdisciplinary education and research in areas like pollution, biodiversity, climate change, and environmental law. The curriculum includes extensive lab and fieldwork, including ecological tours. The Department has awarded degrees to nearly 500 postgraduates and 100 M.Phil./Ph.D. scholars. Over 140 students have qualified for nationallevel exams such as JRF/NET/SET. Research funding exceeding ₹ 8.9 crore has been secured from agencies like DST, MoEF&CC, and JKDST. Additionally, ₹1.16 crore in women-specific fellowships and ₹35.4 lakh through consultancy projects have been obtained. With over 423 publications in high-impact journals and 24 book chapters, the Department's research informs state-level policies. Its well-equipped laboratories support studies on water and air pollution, waste management, and climate change.
