Note:-

- 1. Sealed tenders should be addressed to Executive Engineer, Construction Division, University of Kashmir Hazratbal, Srinagar so as to reach this office by or before <u>01-09-2017</u> to <u>2:00 PM</u> by hand for by registered post.
- 2. The tender document can be had from the office of the Executive Engineer University of Kashmir Hazratbal Srinagar from <u>26-08-2017</u> to <u>30-08-2017</u> up to <u>2:00 PM</u> during office hours after depositing above mentioned document fee (Non-Refundable) in University chest.
- 3. In case the last date for receipt of tenders or date of issue of tender documents is declared as holiday by the government or a closed day due to public strike, transport strike, the last date or receipt of tenders or issue of tender documents (as the case may be) shall be the next working day.
- 4. Tenders not accompanied by the CDR pledged to Executive Engineer, Construction Division,. University of Kashmir for an amount of earnest money as prescribes shall be rejected.
- 5. Tender document shall be issued in person only to those group leaders whose registration card is valid and who have PAN, TIN and upto date tax clearance Certificate issued by the concerned department. Besides the intending tenderer has to produce CDR for an amount mentioned above at the time of issuance of tender document.
- 6. The conditional tender will not be entertained.
- 7. The Executive Engineer, University of Kashmir reserves the right to accept/reject any tender/tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
- 8. The tenderer should quote their rates item-wise as per quantity schedule attached with the document. The rates quoted shall be in words and in figures neatly written in ink.
- 9. The intending tenderers shall to paste transparent cello tape on each and every rate written on the tender document which is compulsory without which the tender will be rejected.
- 10. As soon as the acceptance of the tender/ bid is communicate to the lowest tenderer the contract shall be deemed to commence and a legal binding upon him. The formal deed of agreement incorporating all the terms and conditions including special conditions will govern the contract the formal deed of agreement will be executed immediately within one weeks time to issue of award/ acceptance of the tender. Failure to execute such a formal deed shall not however, prevent the contract being enforced against him. Any loss thus sustained by the University as a result of re-tendering for non-compliance of the conditions of the contract and /or backing out the same shall be recovered from him.
- 11. The rate should be inclusive of all taxes as admissible under rules.
- 12. The items to be executed should be strictly as per quantity schedule and no change in specification will be allowed.
- 13. If the intending tenderer likes to quote rebate, the same shall be quoted in terms of percentage on the quoted rates. Lump sum rebate if quoted the tender shall be rejected.
- 14. The contractor shall arrange, construct and maintain at his cost necessary walk way/platform, ladders, stairways and other facilities of usual and suitable character for all operations on constructions and inspection.
- 15. If the contractor quoted his rate more than the estimated rate to any item or items the rate will be negotiated with the contractor as per the latest CPWD analysis of rates keeping in view the present market rate at the times of tendering.
- 16. The Tender shall be valid for a period of 180-Days from the date of opening of tenders.
